

History of the Medical School

1367	University of Pécs founded by King Louis the Great
1923	Hungarian Royal Erzsébet University transferred to Pécs from Bratislava
1948	Named "University of Sciences of Pécs"
1951	Independent Medical University of Pécs established
1966	New university hospital (400-bed-clinic)
1970	New Central Building of the Medical School
1973	Founding of the Dentistry major
2000	Integration of the Medical University into the University of Pécs – unified University is founded
2003	Adoption of the European Credit Transfer and Accumulation System
2012	János Szentágothai research centre,
2016	Renovation of the Janus Pannonius clinical centre, 2016
2016	Béla Entz clinical education centre,
2016	Medi Skills Lab – Simulation Educational Centre
2016	Faculty of Pharmacy became independent

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Some of our famous professors



János Szentágothai

Was a Kossuth Prize winning Hungarian anatomist, professor, Member of Parliament, and President of the Hungarian Academy of Sciences. The general assembly of UNESCO decided the year 2012 to be dedicated to honour his 100th birthday.




Béla Entz

Was a pathology and forensic medicine professor, rector of the University of Pécs, corresponding member of the Hungarian Academy. Most of his scientific works are important parts of the fundamental works of the classical pathology in Hungary.



Endre Grastyán

Was a nerve physiologist, professor, corresponding member of the Hungarian Academy of Sciences. His research on the functioning of the hippocampus has groundbreaking importance.



György Romhányi

Renowned pathologist researcher and instructor, who first described amyloid submicroscopic structure. Ordinary member of the Hungarian Academy of Sciences.

- **European Union**: Hungarian medical university degrees are recognized in all EU Member States and Switzerland.
- UK: the UP Medical School diploma makes the doctors eligible to register as a doctor in the UK.
- USA: Hungarian graduates (as foreign graduates) have the right to pass the United States Medical Licensing Examinations (USMLE), after which they are eligible for residency.
- Canada: Hungarian graduates (as foreign graduates) are eligible to pass the MCCEE and MCCQE examinations before applying for residency.
















International activities of the University of Pécs





University Library & Knowledge Centre
